1. SECURITY – WILL MY CHILD BE SAFE?

We take the welfare of all our students very seriously and their safety is paramount to us. Thane Villas has an on-site office open all week long and a dedicated team that is available 24/7 if assistance is required. The building has keyfob entry which restricts access to students and staff only. There is an intercom system for visitors. Each floor also has keyfob entry and all rooms are fitted with modern locking systems. Students have their own keyfob and we hold a spare key in case of an emergency. State-of-the-art CCTV surveillance monitors the building's entrance and common areas around the clock. Thane Villas also has the latest fire prevention system with activated rapid response to give further protection and personal reassurance.

2. OUR ROOMS – ARE THEY AS GOOD AS DESCRIBED?

In a word 'yes'. We pride ourselves on the high standards we set both in terms of the facilities on offer and cleanliness we maintain. All our rooms at Thane Villas are en suite and offer a modern, clean and stylish environment for students to study and relax in. Aside from a comfortable bed and fitted wardrobe, there is a desk, plenty of shelving and electrical sockets, a contemporary kitchen equipped with all the essentials – a freezer, cooker, hob, combi microwave, kettle and toaster. Broadband internet is available in all bedrooms and the Common Room and Wi-Fi is available in all the common areas.

- Give them a lesson in budgeting (remember London is often more expensive than other places)
- Make sure you are aware of prohibited items in Thane Villas
- Make sure your child understands and respects our code of conduct
